
**13 Therefore, put on every piece of God's armor so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm.**

**13 And He said to them, “Do you not understand this parable? How then will you understand all the parables?**

**14 The sower sows the word.**

**15 And these are the ones by the wayside where the word is sown. When they hear, Satan comes immediately and takes away the word that was sown in their hearts.**

## **John 6:66-68**

## **Ephesus 6:13-16**

**13 Therefore, put on every piece of God's armor so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm.**

**14 Stand your ground, putting on the belt of truth and the body armor of God's righteousness.**

**15 For shoes, put on the peace that comes from the Good News so that you will be fully prepared.**

**16 In addition to all of these, hold up the shield of faith to stop the fiery arrows of the devil.**

## **1 Peter 5:7-10**

**7 Give all your worries and cares to God, for he cares about you.**

**8 Stay alert! Watch out for your great enemy, the devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour.**

**9 Stand firm against him, and be strong in your faith. Remember that your family of believers all over the world is going through the same kind of suffering you are.**

**10 In his kindness God called you to share in his eternal glory by means of Christ Jesus. So after you have suffered a little while, he will restore, support, and strengthen you, and he will place you on a firm foundation.**

## **Luke 18:1-5**

**1 Then He spoke a parable to them, that men always ought to pray and not lose heart,**

**2 saying: "There was in a certain city a judge who did not fear God nor regard man.**

**3 Now there was a widow in that city; and she came to him, saying, 'Get justice for me from my adversary.'**

**4 And he would not for a while; but afterward he said within himself, 'Though I do not fear God nor regard man**

## **Luke 18:5-8**

**5 yet because this widow troubles me I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary me."**

**6 Then the Lord said, "Hear what the unjust judge said.**


**7 And shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out day and night to Him, though He bears long with them?**

**8 I tell you that He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, will He really find faith on the earth?"**

## **2 Corinthians 10:3-5**

**3-4 For although we live in the natural realm, we don't wage a military campaign employing human weapons, using manipulation to achieve our aims. Instead, our spiritual weapons are energized with divine power to effectively dismantle the defenses behind which people hide.**

**5 We can demolish every deceptive fantasy that opposes God and break through every arrogant attitude that is raised up in defiance of the true knowledge of God. We capture, like prisoners of war, every thought and insist that it bow in obedience to the Anointed One. [TPT]**



# Ground of Hope

## Hebrews 12:2-3

**2 We look away from the natural realm and we fasten our gaze onto Jesus who birthed faith within us and who leads us forward into faith's perfection. His example is this: Because his heart was focused on the joy of knowing that you would be his, he endured the agony of the cross and conquered its humiliation, and now sits exalted at the right hand of the throne of God!**

**3 So consider carefully how Jesus faced such intense opposition from sinners who opposed their own souls, so that you won't become worn down and cave in under life's pressures.**

## Genesis 15:3-6

3 You have given me no descendants of my own, so one of my servants will be my heir.”

4 Then the LORD said to him, “No, your servant will not be your heir, for you will have a son of your own who will be your heir.”

5 Then the LORD took Abram outside and said to him, “Look up into the sky and count the stars if you can. That’s how many descendants you will have!”

6 And Abram believed the LORD, and the LORD counted him as righteous because of his faith.

## **Luke 21:25-28**

**25 “And there will be signs in the sun, in the moon, and in the stars; and on the earth distress of nations, with perplexity, the sea and the waves roaring;**

**26 men’s hearts failing them from fear and the expectation of those things which are coming on the earth, for the powers of the heavens will be shaken.**

**27 Then they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory.**

**28 Now when these things begin to happen, look up and lift up your heads, because your redemption draws near.”**


