## **Acts 10:9-13**

**16 The same vision was repeated three times. Then the sheet was suddenly pulled up to heaven.**


**17 Peter was very perplexed. What could the vision mean? Just then the men sent by Cornelius found Simon’s house.**




# Reading Your Bible

**Jeremiah 15:16**


**16 Your words were found, and I ate them,

# Living For God

## **Romans 7:15-20**

**15-16 What I don't understand about myself is that I decide one way, but then I act another, doing things I absolutely despise. So if I can't be trusted to figure out what is best for myself and then do it, it becomes obvious that God's command is necessary.**

**17-20 But I need something more! For if I know the law but still can't keep it, and if the power of sin within me keeps sabotaging my best intentions, I obviously need help! I realize that I don't have what it takes. I can will it, but I can't do it. I decide to do good, but I don't really do it; I decide not to do bad, but then I do it anyway. My decisions, such as they are, don't result in actions. Something has gone wrong deep within me and gets the better of me every time.**

## **Romans 7:21-24**

**21-23 It happens so regularly that it's predictable. The moment I decide to do good, sin is there to trip me up. I truly delight in God's commands, but it's pretty obvious that not all of me joins in that delight. Parts of me covertly rebel, and just when I least expect it, they take charge.**

**24 I've tried everything and nothing helps. I'm at the end of my rope. Is there no one who can do anything for me? Isn't that the real question?**

## **Romans 8:2,5-7**

**2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.**

**5 For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit.**

**6 For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.**


**7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be.**

## **Galatians 5:16-18**

**16 I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.**

**17 For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish.**

**18 But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.**



# Being A Christian

## **John 3:3-6**

**3 Jesus answered and said to him, “Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.”**

**4 Nicodemus said to Him, “How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother’s womb and be born?”**

**5 Jesus answered, “Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.**

**6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.**

## **2 Corinthians 5:16-17**

**16 Therefore, from now on, we regard no one according to the flesh. Even though we have known Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know Him thus no longer.**

**17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.**

**NKJV**

## **2 Corinthians 5:17**

**17 Therefore if any person is in Christ he is a new creation (a new creature altogether); the old [previous moral and spiritual condition] has passed away. Behold, the fresh and new has come! [AMP]**

## **Ephesians 2:10**

**10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.**

**10 For we are God's handiwork, recreated in Christ Jesus, [born anew] that we may do those good works which God predestined (planned beforehand) for us [taking paths which He prepared ahead of time], that we should walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us to live]. [AMP]**


