## **John 14:16-17 - Jesus Prophesies the Spirit Within**

**16 And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever –**

**17 the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you.**

## **John 20:20-22 - The Disciples Receive the Spirit Within**

**20 Now when He had said this, He showed them His hands and His side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord.**

**21 So Jesus said to them again, "Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you."**

**22 And when He had said this, He breathed on them, and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit.**

## Acts 1:4-5,8

4 Once when he was eating with them, he commanded them, “Do not leave Jerusalem until the Father sends you the gift he promised, as I told you before.

5 John baptized with water, but in just a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.”

8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

**Believing The Gift Is For You**

## Acts 1:4-5

4 Once when he was eating with them, he commanded them, “Do not leave Jerusalem until the Father sends you the gift he promised, as I told you before.

5 John baptized with water, but in just a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.”

## Acts 2:38-39

38 Then Peter said to them, “Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

39 For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call.”

## **Acts 8:6-8,12 - The Samaritan Revival**

**6 Crowds listened intently to Philip because they were eager to hear his message and see the miraculous signs he did.**

**7 Many evil spirits were cast out, screaming as they left their victims. And many who had been paralyzed or lame were healed.**

**8 So there was great joy in that city.**

**12 But now the people believed Philip's message of Good News concerning the Kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ. As a result, many men and women were baptized.**


## Acts 8:14-17 How Peter Responded to Baptized Believers

14 When the apostles in Jerusalem heard that the people of Samaria had accepted God's message, they sent Peter and John there.

15 As soon as they arrived, they prayed for these new believers to receive the Holy Spirit.

16 The Holy Spirit had not yet come upon any of them, for they had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.

17 Then Peter and John laid their hands upon these believers, and they received the Holy Spirit.



**Romans 8:9 - All Believers Have Spirit Within**

**9 Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he is not His.**

## Acts 19:4-7 How Paul Responded to Baptized Believers

4 Then Paul said, “John indeed baptized with a baptism of repentance, saying to the people that they should believe on Him who would come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus.”

5 When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.

6 And when Paul had laid hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they spoke with tongues and prophesied.

7 Now the men were about twelve in all.

## Acts 2:38-39

38 Then Peter said to them, “Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

39 For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call.”

## **1 Corinthians 1:4-7**

**4 I always thank my God for you and for the gracious gifts he has given you, now that you belong to Christ Jesus.**

**6 This confirms that what I told you about Christ is true.**

**7 Now you have every spiritual gift you need as you eagerly wait for the return of our Lord Jesus Christ.**

**7 So that you come behind in no gift; waiting for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ [KJV]**

## 1 Corinthians 13:8-10

8 Love never fails. But whether there are prophecies, they will fail; whether there are tongues, they will cease; whether there is knowledge, it will vanish away.

9 For we know in part and we prophesy in part.

10 But when that which is perfect has come, then that which is in part will be done away.

# **Asking & Receiving By Faith**

## **Romans 10:9-10 Receiving the Gift of Salvation**

**9 If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.**

**10 For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by openly declaring your faith that you are saved.**

## **Ephesians 2:8-9**

**8 For by grace you have been saved through faith,  
and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God,**

**9 not of works, lest anyone should boast.**

## **Luke 11:11-13**

**11 “You fathers—if your children ask for a fish, do you give them a snake instead?”**

**12 Or if they ask for an egg, do you give them a scorpion? Of course not!**

**13 So if you sinful people know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him.”**

## **1 Corinthians 14:14**

**14 For if I pray in a tongue, my spirit prays, but my understanding is unfruitful. [NKJ]**

**14 For if I pray in tongues, my spirit is praying, but I don't understand what I am saying. [NLT]**

---

**14 For if I pray in an [unknown] tongue, my spirit [by the Holy Spirit within me] prays, but my mind is unproductive [it bears no fruit and helps nobody]. [AMP]**


