Safety In His Presence

Matthew 6:5-6

But you, when you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in the secret place; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly.

“Here’s what I want you to do: Find a quiet, secluded place so you won’t be tempted to role-play before God. Just be there as simply and honestly as you can manage. The focus will shift from you to God, and you will begin to sense his grace. [Message]

Psalm 23:1-4

The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

**He makes me to lie down in green pastures;
He leads me beside the still waters.**

**He restores my soul;
He leads me in the paths of righteousness
For His name's sake.**

**Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death,
I will fear no evil; For You are with me;
Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.**

Psalm 32:7

**You are my hiding place;
You shall preserve me from trouble;
You shall surround me with songs of deliverance.**

**Lord, you are my secret hiding place,
protecting me from these troubles,
surrounding me with songs of gladness!
Your joyous shouts of rescue release my breakthrough.**

Psalm 31:20,22-24

**You shall hide them in the secret place of Your presence
From the plots of man;
You shall keep them secretly in a pavilion
From the strife of tongues.**

**For I said in my haste, “I am cut off from before Your eyes”;
Nevertheless You heard the voice of my supplications
When I cried out to You.**

**Oh, love the LORD, all you His saints!
For the LORD preserves the faithful, and fully repays the proud person.
Be of good courage, and He shall strengthen your heart,
All you who hope in the LORD.**



Safety In His Word

Matthew 7:24-25

24 “Therefore whoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock:

25 and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall, for it was founded on the rock.

24-25 “These words I speak to you are not incidental additions to your life, homeowner improvements to your standard of living. They are foundational words, words to build a life on. If you work these words into your life, you are like a smart carpenter who built his house on solid rock. Rain poured down, the river flooded, a tornado hit—but nothing moved that house. It was fixed to the rock. [Message]

Psalm 3:1-3,6

**1 LORD, how they have increased who trouble me!
Many are they who rise up against me.**

**2 Many are they who say of me,
“There is no help for him in God.”**

**3 But You, O LORD, are a shield for me,
My glory and the One who lifts up my head.**

**6 I will not be afraid of ten thousands of people
Who have set themselves against me all around.**

Psalm 119:161-162, 165, 167

**161 Princes persecute me without a cause,
But my heart stands in awe of Your word.**

**162 I rejoice at Your word
As one who finds great treasure.**

**165 Great peace have those who love Your law,
And nothing causes them to stumble.**

**167 My soul keeps Your testimonies,
And I love them exceedingly.**

29 Take my yoke upon you. Let me teach you, because I am humble and gentle at heart, and you will find rest for your souls.
