Fleshly Blind Spots

Checking The “Middle Flesh”

Galatians 5:16-18

16 I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

17 For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish.

18 But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.

Galatians 5:19-21

19 Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness,

20 idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies,

21 envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

The Top Tier (Classic)

Adultery - sexual promiscuity related to marriage (real or imagined)

Fornication - any sexual promiscuity

Uncleanness - sexual impurity (nudity, promiscuity) [medias]

Lewdness - sexual perversion

Idolatry - natural or created objects worshipped as deity; covetousness, greed, food

Sorcery - drug addiction

The Bottom Tier (Classic)

Murders - taking the life of another person (real or imagined)

Drunkenness - intoxication

Revelries - drinking parties

The “MIDDLE” Flesh

Hatred - intense dislike

Contentions - contest or quarrel

Jealousies - fear of losing something/someone you have

Outbursts of wrath - display of extreme anger

Selfish ambitions - consumed with one's own interests, benefits, welfare

Dissensions - disagreement that leads to discord (broken relationships)

Heresies - sect, party (political)

Envy - wanting something/someone that someone else has

Romans 13:12-14

12 The night is far spent, the day is at hand. Therefore let us cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armor of light.

13 Let us walk properly, as in the day, not in revelry and drunkenness, not in lewdness and lust, not in strife and envy.

14 But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts.

Galatians 5:16-17, 22-23

16 I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

17 For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish.

22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,

23 gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

Romans 8:5-6, 12

5 Those who are motivated by the flesh only pursue what benefits themselves. But those who live by the impulses of the Holy Spirit are motivated to pursue spiritual realities.

6 For the mind-set of the flesh is death, but the mindset controlled by the Spirit finds life and peace.

12 So then, beloved ones, the flesh has no claims on us at all, and we have no further obligation to live in obedience to it.



Demonic Blind Spots

Checking The “Wisdom”

James 3:13-16

13 Who is wise and understanding among you? Let him show by good conduct that his works are done in the meekness of wisdom.

14 But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth.

15 This wisdom descends not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish.

16 For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work.

James 3:17-18

17 But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy.

18 Now the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.

Revelation 12:10-11

10 Then I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, “Now salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before our God day and night, has been cast down.

11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.

Ephesians 4:26-27

26-27 “Be angry, and do not sin”: do not let the sun go down on your wrath, nor give place to the devil.

1 John 5:18

18 We know that whoever is born of God does not sin; but he who has been born of God keeps himself, and the wicked one does not touch him.

Colossians 3:12-15

12 Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering;

13 bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do.

14 But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection.

15 And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful.
