James 1:23-25

23 If you listen to the Word and don't live out the message you hear, you become like the person who looks in the mirror of the Word to discover the reflection of his face in the beginning.

24 You perceive how God sees you in the mirror of the Word, but then you go out and forget your divine origin.


25 But those who set their gaze deeply into the perfecting law of liberty are fascinated by and respond to the truth they hear and are strengthened by it—they experience God's blessing in all that they do! 2 Corinthians 4:13,16-18 Speaking The Unseen

13 We have the same Spirit of faith that is described in the Scriptures when it says, "First I believed, then I spoke in faith."

16 That is why we never give up. Though our bodies are dying, our spirits are being renewed every day.

17 For our present troubles are small and won't last very long. Yet they produce for us a glory that vastly outweighs them and will last forever!

18 So we don't look at the troubles we can see now; rather, we fix our gaze on things that cannot be seen. For the things we see now will soon be gone, but the things we cannot see will last forever.



2 Peter 1:3-4 Gazing Into The Promises

3 His divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness.

4 As a result of this, he has given you magnificent promises that are beyond all price, so that through the power of these tremendous promises you can experience partnership with the divine nature, by which you have escaped the corrupt desires that are of the world.

Speaking Your Gaze Declaring What You See

Romans 10:8-10 Speaking The Salvation Reflection

8-9 But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" (that is, the word of faith which we preach): that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

2 Corinthians 4:13

13 We have the same Spirit of faith that is described in the Scriptures when it says, "First I believed, then I spoke in faith."

Hebrews 13:5-6

5 For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you."

6 So we may boldly say:

"The LORD is my helper; I will not fear. What can man do to me?" Romans 8:29-31

29 For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.

30 Having determined our destiny ahead of time, he called us to himself and transferred his perfect righteousness to everyone he called. And those who possess his perfect righteousness he co-glorified with his Son!

31 What then shall we say [speak] to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?

Matthew 12:34b The Mouth Speaks What's In The Heart

For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks. [NK]

For whatever is in your heart determines what you say. [NLT]

For what has been stored up in your hearts will be heard in the overflow of your words! [TPT]

For the mouth speaks what the heart is full of. [GNB]

For out of the overflow of the heart the mouth speaks. [NIV]

Mark 11:22-24 Faith Speaks

22 So Jesus answered and said to them, "Have faith in God.

23 For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.

24 Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.

Speaking Under Authority Saying What You Hear

John 12:49-50 Jesus Spoke By Permission

49 I don't speak on my own authority. The Father who sent me has commanded me what to say and how to say it.

50 And I know his commands lead to eternal life; so I say whatever the Father tells me to say."

John 14:10

10 The words I speak are not my own, but my Father who lives in me does his work through me.

John 16:12-14

12 "I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now.

13 However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.

14 He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you.

James 1:5 Asking God For Wisdom

5 If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.

James 3:17-18 Receiving God's Wisdom

17 But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy.

18 Now the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.

Speaking Through Prayer Asking To See More

Ephesians 1:16-19 Partake of Revelation

16 I do not cease to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers:

17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him,

18 the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints,

19 and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe

Ephesians 3:16-19

16 [I pray] that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man,

17 that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love,

18 may be able to **comprehend** with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height—

19 to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18


Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.


Philemon 6
